**Owners:** ALLOIN Family

**Vineyard area:** 1,25 acres

**Soil types:** Sandy-clay

**Planting density:** 6 500 vines /ha

**Average age of the vines:** 5 years

**Grape variety:** Malbec

**Cultivation method:** rational cultivation

**Pruning:** Poussard pruning method

**Soil management:** natural grass cover every other row and tillage

**Yield:** 40-45 hl per hectare

**Harvest:** picking by hand using trays.

The grapes are sorted in the vineyard and in the cellar.

The harvest is protected in a refrigerated cellule.

**Winemaking technique and barrel ageing:** cold soak skin contact maceration.

Integral vinification and ageing in amphorae

**Annual production:** around 900 bottles
